2021 LAS VEGAS RAIDERS TRAINING CAMP



RAIDERS IN HENDERSON

The Las Vegas Raiders will begin their 2021 campaign at Raiders Headquarters/Intermountain Healthcare Performance Center for the second straight season. This will mark the first training camp in Las Vegas where guests will be in attendance to view practices.

The Silver and Black enter 2021 under the direction of **Head Coach Jon Gruden**, now in year four of his second stint at the helm of the Raiders. The club finished last season with a record of 8-8, standing second in the AFC West with a one-win improvement from the 2019 campaign and four-win improvement from 2018. On Aug. 14, the team will host their first preseason contest at Allegiant Stadium since arriving in Las Vegas when they host the Seattle Seahawks.

MAP DETAILS AND ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

Entry for parking is located on the Northeast side of the Intermountain Healthcare Performance center. Identification must be presented at the gate to be approved for entry by security.

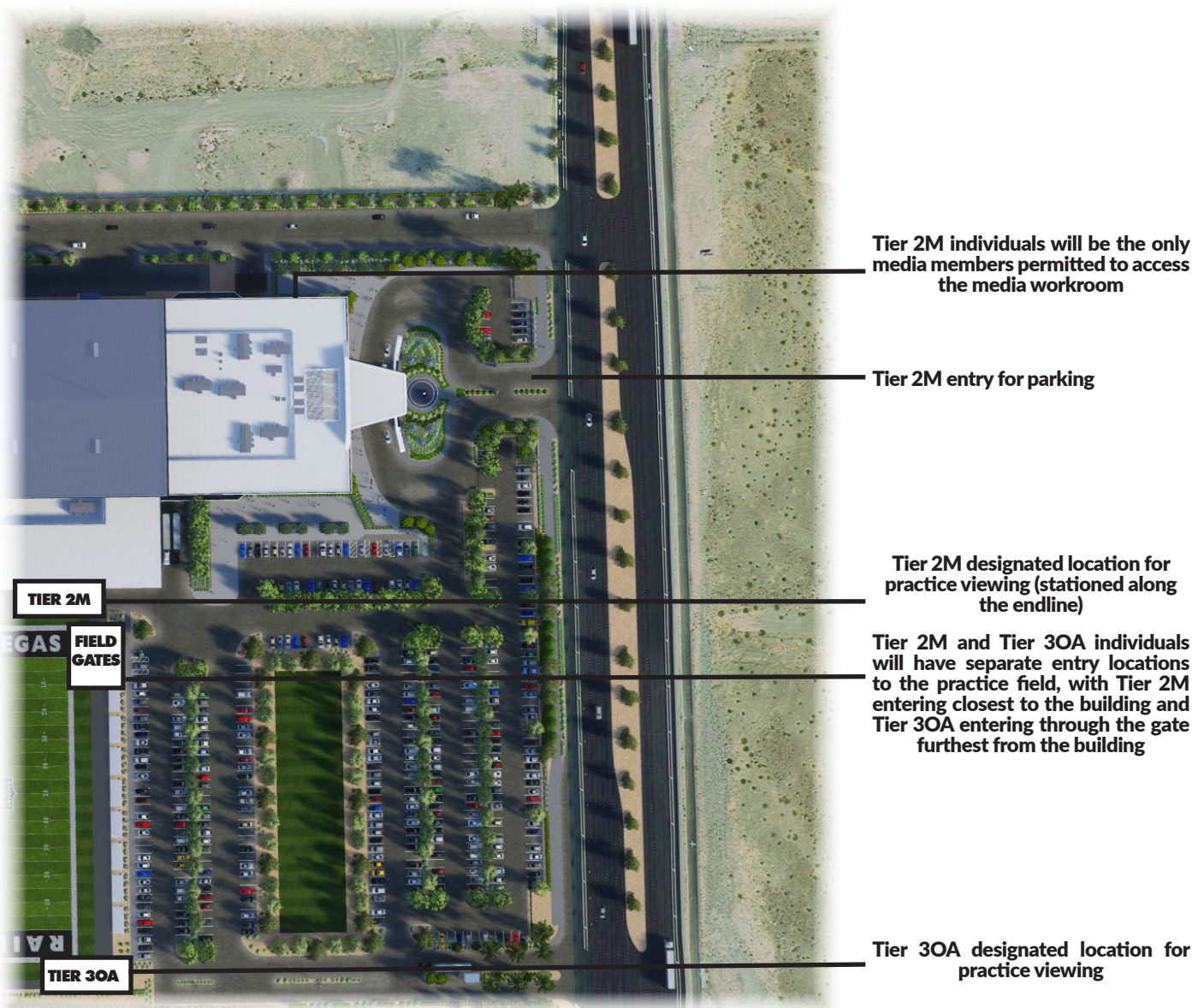
Parking for Tier 2M individuals is located on the very far West end of the parking lot that runs alongside Raiders Way by the torch. Parking anywhere else in the lot will not be permitted. Parking for Tier 3OA will be located at the M Resort Spa Casino.

Check-in for all Tier 2M individuals is located on the North side of the Intermountain Healthcare Performance Center in the media work room and will be staffed by a member of the media relations department.

Check-in and access to the field is available 30 minutes prior to the start of practice. Each media member must pick up his/her own individual credential and present corresponding photo identification.

Check-in for all Tier 3OA is located at the West entrance of the M Resort Spa Casino. A Raiders ambassador will be in attendance and will approve Tier 3OA media entry upon proof of identification.

Due to COVID-19 protocols, there will be two separate locations for Tier 2M and Tier 3OA to view practice. Media must remain in their designated locations throughout the duration of practice. Designated locations are show on the map below.





TRAINING CAMP MEDIA ACCESS & POLICY



MEDIA INFORMATION & POLICIES

Members of the media are encouraged to carefully review the following procedures, reminded that these are subject to change. Media can retrieve up-to-date schedules and information via Twitter @RAIDERS_PR.

PRACTICE ACCESS & PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY GUIDELINES: Approximately the first 30 minutes, or until the “team” portion of the practice are open to photography and videography. The team reserves the right to limit photography to certain periods due to competitive-advantage reasons. Media should stand at a safe distance and hold all belongings, including bags and video cameras. Tripods are not allowed on the field during practice, for safety reasons.

PRACTICE REPORTING POLICY: Blogging and tweeting from offseason, training camp and regular-season practices are permitted for practices that are open to the public. For all practices that are closed to the public, blogging and tweeting are permitted only within the designated viewing window. Consistent with Super Bowl reporting protocol for practices, the following are general reporting policies for all media, including blogging and tweeting:

- Media may note which players are practicing as well as those who are not.
- Media may report non-strategy and non-game plan observations.
- Not permitted is any reference to plays run or game strategy. This includes describing formations, personnel groupings (i.e. composition of offensive line) or non-conventional (i.e. “trick”) plays.
- Not permitted is the reporting of which players are practicing with individual units (goal line offense, nickel/ dime defense, etc.)
- Not permitted is the reporting of practice injuries until the team has provided an official update.
- Access to the head coach following practice will be provided for comments and injury updates.
- Not permitted is quoting, paraphrasing or reporting comments made by coaches, players or team personnel during a practice session.
- Not permitted are any photo/video transmissions after the designated shooting period has closed.
- Not permitted are wide-view photos/videos of formations and/or personnel groupings (shots must be tightly focused on the player/ ball.)
- Not permitted is any audio of quarterback cadence, keywords, audibles, etc.
- All cell phones must be turned to “silent” or “vibrate” mode for practice and all post-practice press conferences.

CREDENTIAL REQUESTS: Credential requests for practice will be honored only for working media on specific assignment for a recognized news or sports organization. Credentials will not be issued to freelance writers or photographers. All credential requests for training camp practices should be made at least 48 hours in advance to Katie Agostin (kagostin@raiders.com) of the Raiders' media relations office.

MEDIA WORKROOM: The media workroom is located on the North side of the Intermountain Healthcare Performance Center and permitted only to Tier-2M members.

LIVE BROADCASTING POLICY: Media are not permitted to live broadcast any Raiders practices or media availabilities without prior approval by a member of the media relations staff. Social media applications with live streaming functionality - Facebook, Instagram, Periscope, etc. - are included in this policy.

INTERVIEW REQUESTS: The Raiders respectfully ask that all interview requests, for any member of the organization, be submitted through the team's media relations office. Players, coaches or staff should not be contacted by media directly by telephone, e-mail, or via social media, including Twitter.

GENERAL MANAGER MIKE MAYOCK INTERVIEWS: Media wishing to request interviews with the Raiders' general manager should contact Will Kiss (wkiss@raiders.com). Interviews are scheduled as time allows.

HEAD COACH JON GRUDEN INTERVIEWS: Head Coach Jon Gruden is available after most practices. Media wishing to request interviews with the head coach should contact Will Kiss (wkiss@raiders.com). Interviews are scheduled as time allows.

QB DEREK CARR INTERVIEWS: Derek Carr is available to the media during training camp on select days, which are designated on the media schedule. Media wishing to request interviews with Carr should contact Evert Geerlings (egee@raiders.com). Interviews are scheduled as time allows.

ASSISTANT COACH INTERVIEWS: Those requesting interviews with Assistant Head Coach/Special Teams Coordinator Rich Bisaccia, Defensive Coordinator Gus Bradley or Offensive Coordinator Greg Olson should contact Will Kiss (wkiss@raiders.com). Other assistant coaches are available by request, provided the request is made at least 24 hours in advance to the Raiders media relations staff. During training camp, coordinators are available at the podium when scheduled.

PLAYER INTERVIEWS: Players are available after practice and all one-on-one requests should be made through the media relations office. See the training camp calendar for a full schedule of pre-scheduled availability (dates and times subject to change). Weekly schedules with particular player availability will be distributed closer to the date.

- The Raiders have faced the Chargers 122 times, the most of any opponent. They have faced the Broncos and Chiefs each 121 times, as they only played each team once during the strike-shortened 1982 season.

2021 PRESEASON

- The Raiders are 135-135-1 (.500) all-time in preseason contests.
- The 2021 NFL season will feature each team playing 17 regular-season games and three preseason games, marking the first change to the season structure since the 1978 campaign ushered in an era of 16 regular-season and four preseason games.
- The Raiders will play three opponents from the NFC West and each game will be featured locally on FOX 5 KVVU-TV and Raider Nation Radio 920AM in Las Vegas.
- The Silver and Black will play host to Seattle in the opener, marking the 19th overall time the two teams will meet in the preseason and 15th consecutive season.
- The Raiders will play at Los Angeles Rams in Week 2, marking the fourth consecutive season the two teams have met in the preseason. The contest will be broadcast on NFL Network.
- Las Vegas will conclude their preseason slate on the road against the San Francisco 49ers. It will mark the first time the two clubs have met in an exhibition contest since 2011 and the clubs' 40th overall matchup between each other in the preseason.



DIVISIONAL BREAKDOWN

AFC WEST: Denver Broncos, Kansas City Chiefs, Los Angeles Chargers

- The Chiefs finished 14-2 and won the AFC West crown for the fifth straight season, while making their second consecutive Super Bowl appearance.
- The Raiders finished 4-2 against the AFC West in 2020, sweeping the Denver Broncos for the first time since 2010, defeating the Chiefs on the road for the first time since 2012 and beating the Los Angeles Chargers on the road in Week 9.
- Since divisional realignment in 2002, the Raiders have posted a winning record in the AFC West three times: 4-2 in 2002 and 2020, and 6-0 in 2010.

AFC East: Miami Dolphins

- The Raiders are 76-73-4 (.510) all-time against the AFC East and will face the Dolphins for the second straight year after hosting Miami in Week 16 last year.

AFC South: Indianapolis Colts

- Las Vegas owns a 43-41 (.512) combined all-time advantage against AFC South opponents, and will face the Colts for the fourth consecutive year after hosting Indianapolis in Week 14 last season.

AFC North: Baltimore Ravens, Cincinnati Bengals, Cleveland Browns and Pittsburgh Steelers

- The Raiders are 49-39 (.557) all-time against the AFC North. The Silver and Black have played the most games (30) against the Bengals, holding a 19-11 advantage in the all-time series.
- The Raiders went 2-2 against the AFC North in 2018.

NFC East: Dallas Cowboys, Philadelphia Eagles, New York Giants, Washington Football Team

- The Raiders are 26-24 (.520) all-time against the NFC East. The Silver and Black lead the all-time series against the Giants and Eagles and are tied in the all-time series against the Cowboys.
- The Silver and Black last played the division in 2017, finishing 1-3.

NFC East: Chicago Bears

- The Raiders are 31-27 (.534) all-time against the NFC North, with a record of 8-7 against the Bears.

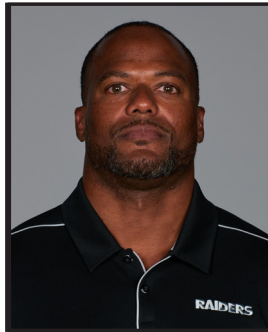

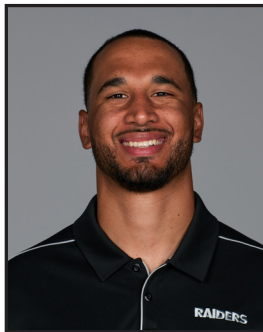
